OUR MISSION

is to break down institutional barriers to recording music in prisons and provide incarcerated and formerly incarcerated people a high-quality platform for their voices to be heard. We provide our collaborators the tools to carry out top tier albums from start to completion, allowing them to strengthen their sense of identity and professionalism in an environment that often prohibits intellectual and creative growth. Our musicians lift up the unheard stories of some of the most marginalized people in our communities, changing the narrative on prison in America.

THROUGH OUR WORK

we aim to build cultural power for incarcerated and formerly incarcerated people, and increase public awareness of systemic racism, mass incarceration, and inequity in policing and the judicial system, centering the voices of those directly impacted.



Dear Friend of DJC,


You might be thinking, whether you're reading this in 2021 or in 2121, we could not have picked a stranger time to launch as a record label: 2020. A global pandemic the likes of which the world had not seen for a century. A summer of protests with an energy of the 1960s and 70s. Masses of people stuck at home, separated from their loved ones, at risk of catching a deadly virus. And yet for all the calamities 2020 held, with grit, passion, and a ton of volunteer hours, Die Jim Crow Records had a remarkable first year officially as a record label.

It started out as a more normal year would, with us recording in two South Carolina prisons for upcoming projects B. Alexis and The Masses. Following those sessions, I travelled to Nashville to lay down a bunch of instrumentation for the Territorial project with some seasoned Americana players. Meanwhile, BL Shirelle's debut album (and our label's first full length LP!) was in the mixing process, and things were off to an exciting start.

As the world began to shut down in March, we became very concerned about the musicians we work with in prison and knew we had to do something. After a couple long conversations with BL, who is also our Deputy Director, we decided to push the release of her album and launch a PPE Into Prisons campaign in an attempt to help serve our community; some of the country's most vulnerable.

And that we did. From April 13 to October 28, our PPE campaign raised over \$25,000 and helped us send 30,285 masks to 26 prisons and jails in 16 states. Engaging our fans stuck at home, we held 20 virtual concerts featuring 138 performers from all over world, 18 of whom were formerly or currently incarcerated. While this was a shift in direction, it was well worth it. Initiatives like our PPE Into Prisons campaign show the public that, while high-quality music and art is what drives us, we are an organization of activists as well; and the two are of equal importance.

On Juneteenth 2020, BL Shirelle's *Assata Troi* released to wide media attention in the LA Times, BBC, NPR, and Pitchfork. A sonic exploration of hip hop, rock, and R&B, the album is about owning one's past pain and turning it into power. As an LGBTQ Black artist/activist who served ten years in prison, BL's message came at a crucial time for the culture, and I believe the reaches of this album have not even scratched the surface yet.

In September, we teased the Territorial album with the release of “America The Merciful,” the album's first single, which premiered on Grammys.com along with an in-depth article on the project. Our last release of the year, “The Meaning of Christmas,” also gave a taste of what is to come with Territorial, as bandmember Michael Tenneson is the track's singer and author, and it was mixed by Matthew Cullen (Lady Gaga, My Morning Jacket, Lana Del Rey). This song's catchiness and depth you'll find more of with the long-awaited *Tlaxihuiqui* (Summer 2021), Territorial's first LP offering.

Though the year held many unexpected turns, it was ultimately a time of growth and settling in at a reasonable pace. All of the time spent indoors helped us strengthen our team and our administrative capacity. We learned to coordinate better, to schedule more realistically, and to be adaptable in times of unexpected duress.

We also grappled with the challenges that come with being a new and growing non-profit. Our team, including myself, is still largely volunteer, and we're able to continue our work by having other jobs that support us or by subletting our apartments and living with parents (hint hint at my sitch).

And yet we've never been in a better place. We saw a growth of 31% in revenue last year, and are shooting for a 50% growth this year*. We have *Tlaxihuiqui* dropping in August and B. Alexis in the Fall. The Masses to follow in 2022. And much more. So, I'm hopeful and excited. Also grateful... that you're here for the journey!

“Prior to DJC I’d been struggling with what to do with my music. I figured with a thirty year sentence I’d be too old to come out trying to establish myself as a ‘renowned rapper.’ So I had all these brainstorming ideas that really didn’t sit well with me; sell my lyrics, turn them into poetry, use them in a memoir, or just trash them. I thought those were my only options. It never dawned on me that while in prison I’d see my dream coming true, but DJC has given me a platform to express; to show my music on a professional level I didn’t think possible. In the process I’ve met some awesome and authentic people and I feel honored to call DJC’s ‘motley crew of misfits’ my friends.”

NEW RECORDINGS

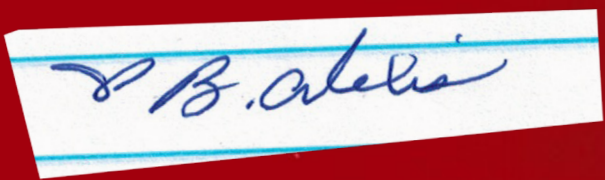
In February, DJC recorded two upcoming projects out of South Carolina: The Masses, an LP recorded with a 10-member hip-hop collective at Allendale Correctional Facility, and B. Alexis, whose project will be the first solo album ever recorded by a woman in prison.



The Masses, whose project will also be a debut, put forward nuanced explorations of racial profiling and the trauma inflicted by prisons alongside powerful lyrics that speak to the group’s collective power: “The Masses / Movement / Voice of the voiceless / Soldiers of fortune / The poor and unfortunate...”

B. Alexis, who is serving a 30 year sentence, takes us on an introspective journey of a street-smart-meets-book-smart rapper who channels the firmness of Scarface and the mystique of Lauryn Hill.

Closing out the trip in early March, we spent two days in Nashville recording dazzling instrumentation with veteran Americana session players for the upcoming Territorial project.



VIRTUAL VOLUMES KICKOFF



Following the success of our PPE Into Prisons concerts, on #GivingTuesday we launched Virtual Volumes, a monthly benefit concert series that features musicians on our roster alongside other musicians who are invested in our mission, including several popular artists such as DIIV, Shamir, The Nude Party and KeiYaA. Volume one had over 70 RSVPs and raised over \$1.5K for the Territorial LP’s mixing and mastering costs.



ASSATA TROI ALBUM LAUNCH



In celebration of the Assata Troi album release, BL Shirelle hosted an album launch in which she honored ten formerly incarcerated women for their contributions as activists and entrepreneurs in their communities. Each woman spoke on their experiences reintegrating successfully into society. Assata Troi, which means “she who struggles is a warrior,” could not have been a more fitting album to honor in this fashion.

As a response to the COVID pandemic, DJC launched a crowdfunding campaign to help keep folks in prison safe.

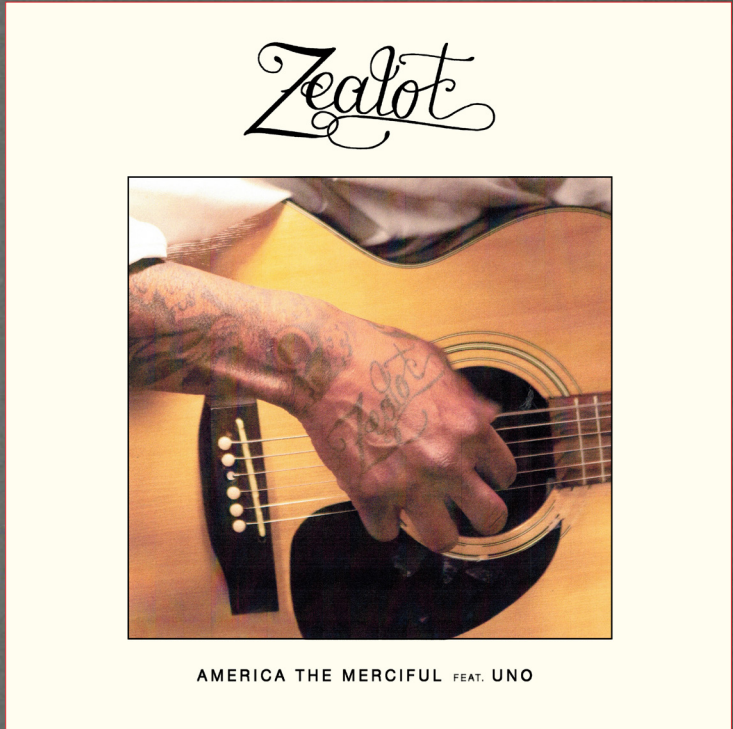

RELEASES

In 2020 we released our first full length album, BL Shirelle's critically acclaimed *Assata Troi*, which was called "passionate and poetic" by The Philadelphia Inquirer.

In addition to a single and music video from BL's album, we released our first single from the Territorial project, "America The Merciful," which premiered on Grammys.com.

In total we released 1 LP and 3 Singles featuring three incarcerated artists and three formerly incarcerated artists.



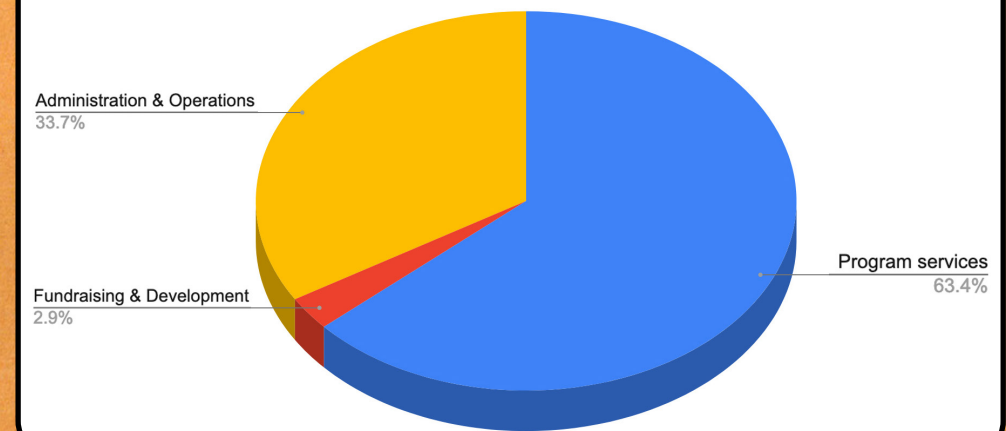

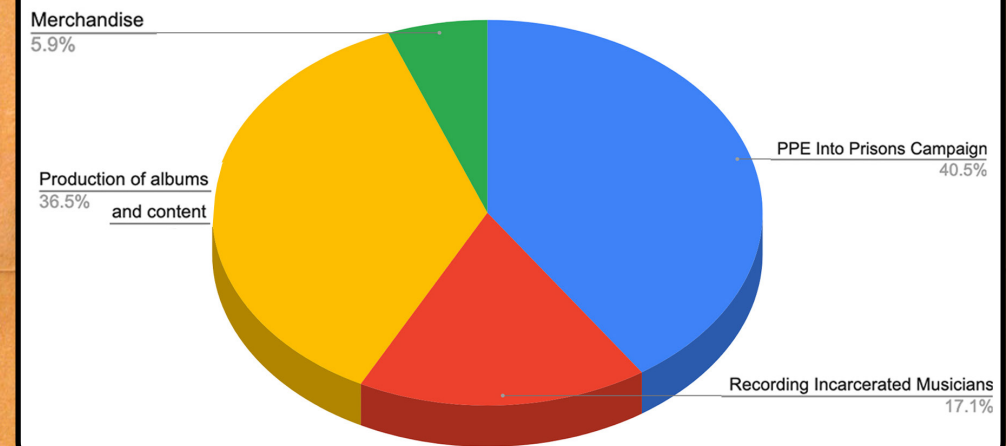

Percent Breakdown of Program Expenses



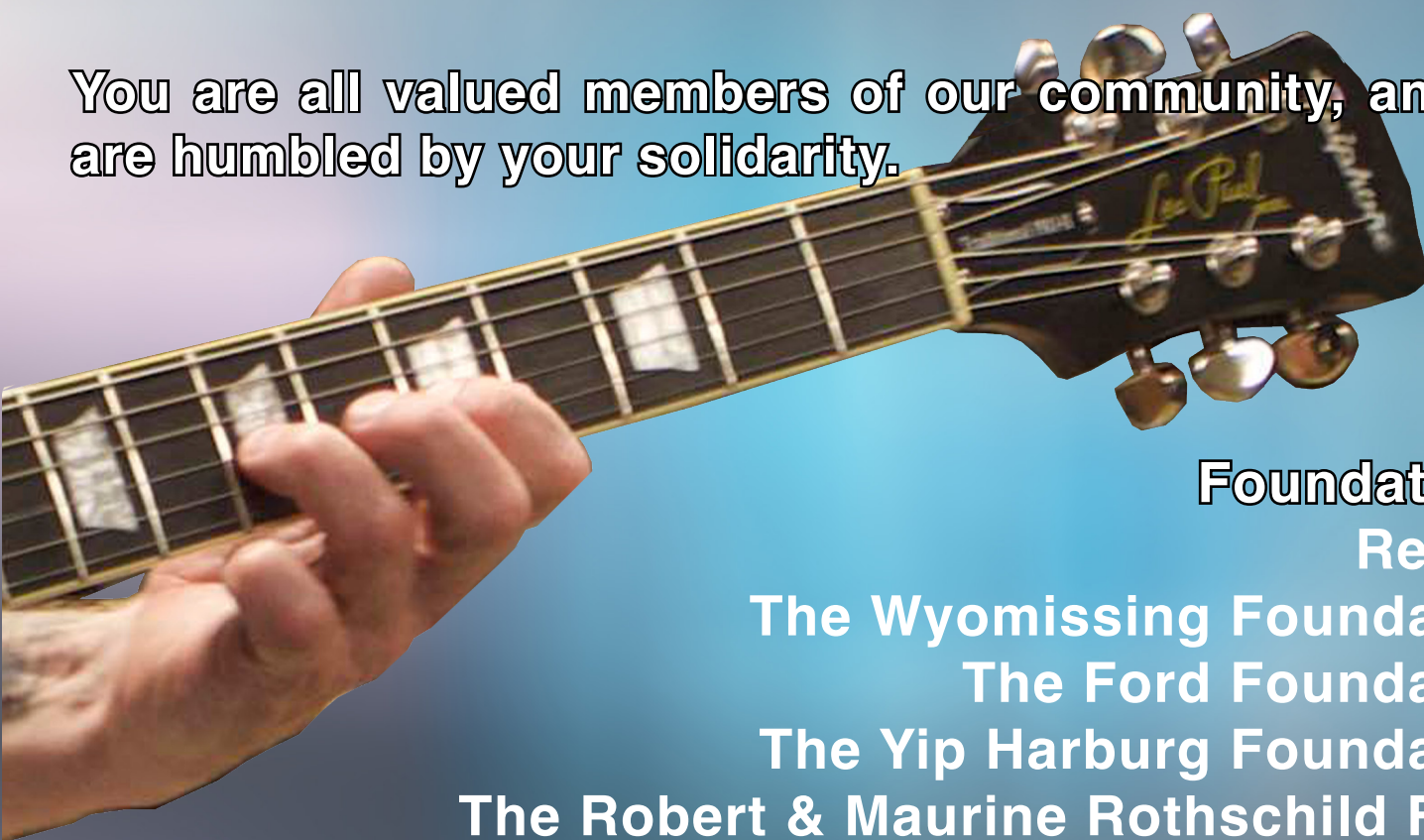
